RESOLUTION (81) 36

ON THE REMUNERATION OF SPECIALLY APPOINTED OFFICIALS

(Adopted by the Committee of Ministers on 7 December 1981 at the 341st meeting of the Ministers' Deputies)

The Committee of Ministers, under the terms of Article 16 of the Statute of the Council of Europe,

Having regard to Resolution (71) 8 on the remuneration of specially appointed officials of the Council of Europe, as last amended by Resolution (81) 2;

Having regard to the decision reached at the 341st meeting of the Ministers' Deputies approving the 187th report of the Co-ordinating Committee of Government Budget Experts on the new salary scales for A and L grade members of the permanent staff with effect from 1 July 1981;

Whereas, as a result of that decision, and in accordance with Article 2 of Resolution (71) 8 referred to above, new basic salary scales for the specially appointed officials of the Council of Europe need to be established,

Resolves as follows:

Single article — The basic annual salaries laid down in Article 1, paragraph a, of Resolution (71) 8, as last amended by Resolution (81) 2, shall be adjusted as follows with effect from 1 July 1981:
