#### RESOLUTION (83) 24

## CONCERNING THE PARTIAL AGREEMENT IN THE SOCIAL AND PUBLIC HEALTH FIELD 1984 BUDGET

(Adopted by the Committee of Ministers on 9 December 1983 at the 365th meeting of the Ministers' Deputies)

The Committee of Ministers, under the terms of Article 16 of the Statute of the Council of Europe, and with membership restricted to the Representatives of the States Parties to the Partial Agreement in the Social and Public Health Field<sup>1</sup>,

Having regard to Resolution (59) 23 of 16 November 1959 establishing a Partial Agreement in the Social and Public Health Field;

Having regard to Articles 19, 21 and 28 of the Financial Regulations;

Having regard to Resolution (74) 25 of 28 June 1974 fixing the scale of contributions of member states to the budget of the Partial Agreement in the Social and Public Health Field, as amended by Resolution (82) 8 of 11 October 1982;

Having regard to the draft budget for 1984 submitted by the Secretary General (Doc. CM (83) 152, Part 4);

Having regard to the report of the Budget Committee dated 25 October 1983 (Doc. CM (83) 189), Resolves as follows:

- 1. The budget of expenditure for 1984, totalling 4 541 000 FF and divided into heads and sub-heads according to Table A appended hereto and the budget of receipts totalling 4 541 000 FF according to Table B appended hereto are hereby approved.
- 2. Approval is hereby given to the apportionment, among the states which are Parties to the Partial Agreement in the Social and Public Health Field, of the contributions for 1984, totalling 4 342 500 FF as shown in Table C appended hereto.
