RESOLUTION (66) 35

(adopted by the Ministers' Deputies on 24th September 1966)

UNIVERSITY CONVENTIONS

The Committee of Ministers,

Considering Recommendation No. 26 on University Conventions submitted to it by the CCC at the instigation of its Committee for Higher Education and Research,

Resolves that no State which is not a Member of the Council of Europe or has not acceded to the European Cultural Convention be invited to accede to the European Convention on the Equivalence of Diplomas leading to admission to Universities or the European Convention on the Academic Recognition of University Qualifications without the Committee for Higher Education and Research and the Committee for General and Technical Education first being asked, through the agency of the CCC, to advise whether the school and university system of the country to be invited is essentially equivalent to that of the present signatories of the Conventions.
