POLITICAL PRISONERS IN ARGENTINA WHO HAVE OBTAINED A VISA
TO GO INTO EXILE
Recommendation 908 and Order No. 393
(Concl(81)328/8, CM(81)69)

Decision

The Deputies adopted the following reply to Recommendation 908:

"1. The Committee of Ministers has examined Assembly Recommendation 908 on political prisoners in Argentina who have obtained a visa to go into exile as well as the letters from the President of the Assembly and the Chairman of the Assembly's Committee on Migration, Refugees and Demography concerning more recent information given by Amnesty International on the prisoners indicated in the explanatory report on Recommendation 908 (Doc. 4644).

2. The Committee of Ministers wishes to inform the Assembly that the member States share the Assembly's concern about the problems of political prisoners in Argentina and that they are following with close attention all developments in that matter. Measures have already been taken by many member States to facilitate the admission and settlement of Argentinian political prisoners and refugees on their territory.

3. Member States will bear in mind the contents of paragraph 9 of Recommendation 908 in the light of new developments and make use of those policies which are most likely to help the political prisoners in Argentina."
