### RESOLUTION (73) 47

## CONCERNING THE INCREASE IN THE WORKING CAPITAL FUND

(Adopted by the Committee of Ministers on 18 December 1973 at the 227th meeting of the Deputies)

The Committee of Ministers,

Having regard to Article 14 of the Financial Regulations;

Having regard to the proposals made by the Secretary General in Document CM (73) 194;

Having regard to the recommendation made by the Budget Committee in its report of September 1973 (Doc. CM (73) 191);

Considering that it is appropriate to increase the Working Capital Fund,

Resolves:

- 1. To increase the Working Capital Fund from 1983 600 F to 6000 000 F and apportion it between the member States as shown in column A of the appended table;
- 2. To authorise the Secretary General to call for payment from the member States of the difference of 4 016 400 F apportioned as indicated in column C of the appended table.
