RESOLUTION (75) 27

ON REMUNERATION OF SPECIALLY APPOINTED OFFICIALS

(Adopted by the Committee of Ministers on 17 October 1975 at the 249th meeting of the Ministers' Deputies)

The Committee of Ministers,

Having regard to Resolution (71) 8 on the remuneration of specially appointed officials, adopted by the Ministers' Deputies on 26 March 1971;

Having regard to paragraphs 3 to 5 of the report of the Budget Committee, dated 29 April 1975 (Doc. CM (75) 110);

Having regard to the exceptional nature of the sum for repayment over five years of the amount contracted for by the Secretary General for finishing and fitting out his residence ;

Considering that, in view of the rise in the cost of living index since March 1971, the annual amount of the representational allowance payable to the three specially appointed officials should be revised,

Resolves as follows :

Article 1

The amount of the official residence allowance granted to the Secretary General, as laid down in Article 1.c of Resolution (71) 8, is increased to 67 500 FF a year with effect from 1 January 1975.¹

Article 2

The annual amount of the representational allowance payable to the three specially appointed officials, laid down in Article 1.d of Resolution (71) 8, is modified as follows with effect from 1 January 1975 :

- Secretary General	46 000 FF
- Deputy Secretary General (present holder of appointment)	35 850 FF
— Clerk of the Assembly	17 900 FF
