In addition to the information given on the enclosed leaflets I would say that Neath has a population of 66,000 based on the ancient town of Neath which was the site of a Roman fort at a crossing of the River Neath. It developed as an industrial town in the 19th century based on the coal, steel and timplate industries. More recently there have been important developments in the oil-based petro-chemical industries.

Neath is situate on the Bristol Channel, some 38 miles to the west of Cardiff and 8 miles from Swansea, which it adjoins on its western boundary.
