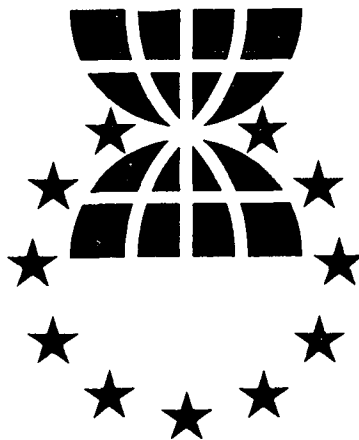

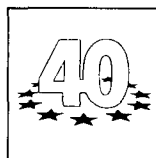

## INTRODUCTION

This international Conference is organised and hosted by the Council of Europe's Standing Conference of Local and Regional Authorities of Europe (CLRAE) and the Municipality of Lisbon, the National Association of Portuguese Municipalities (ANMP) and the Union of Capital Cities of Portuguese-speaking Countries (UCCLA).

## PURPOSE OF THE CONFERENCE

As part of the follow-up to the Council of Europe's Campaign on North/South Interdependence and Solidarity, the Conference in Lisbon is designed to examine the particular role of towns and regions in North/South co-operation and development.

The focus, therefore, will be on mechanisms such as town twinnings, exchange of technical know-how, the role of the private sector in co-operation with local and regional authorities and the collaboration of non-governmental organisations with local and regional authorities.

## LIKELY PARTICIPANTS

The Conference will be of interest to the main international associations of local and regional authorities; representatives of appropriate international agencies, specialised non-governmental organisations; leading figures and senior officers in local and regional authorities; members of universities and research centres; regional and urban organisations in countries outside Europe; architects, town planners and urban technical experts; members of the business community.

## DATE AND PLACE

The Conference will be held at the Hotel Altis in Lisbon.

It will open in the morning of Wednesday 18 October and conclude at 13.00 on Friday 20 October 1989.

### General Theme

"Managing Urban Development: North/South Solidarity"

- "Partnership between towns and non-governmental organisations in co-operation and development"
- "Co-operation between local and regional authorities and the private sector"
