

## Resolution CM/Res(2019)37

### **concerning the budgetary management accounts of the Enlarged Partial Agreement on the Co-operation Group for the Prevention of, Protection Against, and Organisation of Relief in Major Natural and Technological Disasters (EUR-OPA) for the year ended 31 December 2018**

*(Adopted by the Committee of Ministers on 21 November 2019  
at the 1361<sup>st</sup> (Budget) meeting of the Ministers' Deputies)*

The Committee of Ministers, under the terms of Article 16 of the Statute of the Council of Europe, and in its composition restricted to the representatives of the States members in 2018 of the Enlarged Partial Agreement on the Co-operation Group for the Prevention of, Protection Against, and Organisation of Relief in Major Natural and Technological Disasters (EUR-OPA),<sup>1</sup>

Having regard to Article 68 of the Financial Regulations;

Having regard to the budgetary management accounts of the Enlarged Partial Agreement on the Co-operation Group for the Prevention of, Protection Against, and Organisation of Relief in Major Natural and Technological Disasters (EUR-OPA) for the year ended 31 December 2018, as presented by the Secretary General;

Having regard to the opinion of the External Auditor;

Having regard to the report of the External Auditor;

Having regard to the report of the Budget Committee,

Decides:

1. The budgetary management accounts of the Enlarged Partial Agreement on the Co-operation Group for the Prevention of, Protection Against, and Organisation of Relief in Major Natural and Technological Disasters (EUR-OPA) for the year ended 31 December 2018 are approved (CM(2019)100-add, page 37).
2. The unexpended appropriations for the financial year 2018 before provisions amounting to €55 109.10, as shown in the budgetary management accounts presented by the Secretary General, are cancelled.
3. The Secretary General is hereby discharged from financial responsibility in respect of the financial year 2018.
4. Agreed that the credit balance of the Enlarged Partial Agreement on the Co-operation Group for the Prevention of, Protection Against, and Organisation of Relief in Major Natural and Technological Disasters (EUR-OPA) for the financial year 2018 (€48 409.10) be transferred to a suspense account where the appropriations will be frozen pending the payment of the significant outstanding balance of obligatory contributions. The final allocation of this amount will be decided by the Committee of Ministers.
