## Resolution CM/ResCPT(2021)3

### Election of members of the European Committee for the Prevention of Torture and Inhuman or Degrading Treatment or Punishment (CPT) in respect of Austria, Cyprus, Luxembourg, Poland, Serbia, Turkey and Ukraine

*(Adopted by the Committee of Ministers on 22 September 2021  
at the 1412<sup>th</sup> meeting of the Ministers' Deputies)*

The Committee of Ministers, under the terms of Article 5.1 of the European Convention for the Prevention of Torture and Inhuman or Degrading Treatment or Punishment (hereafter referred to as "the Convention"),

Having regard to Articles 1 and 4 of the Convention;

Considering that the seats in respect of Poland and Cyprus have been vacant since 20 December 2019 and 6 March 2020 respectively and that the terms of office of the members of the CPT in respect of Austria, Luxembourg, Serbia, Turkey and Ukraine will expire on 19 December 2021;

Considering that, in the light of the foregoing, it is necessary to elect members of the Committee in respect of these seven countries;

Having regard to the lists of names drawn up by the Bureau of the Parliamentary Assembly, in accordance with the provisions of Article 5, paragraph 1 of the Convention, on the basis of proposals from the Representatives of Austria, Cyprus, Luxembourg, Poland, Serbia, Turkey and Ukraine to the Parliamentary Assembly and forwarded to the Chairperson of the Ministers' Deputies by the Secretary General of the Parliamentary Assembly;

Having regard to the provisions of Article 5, paragraphs 3 and 4, of the Convention;

Having voted by secret ballot,

1. declares the following candidate elected as member of the European Committee for the Prevention of Torture and Inhuman or Degrading Treatment or Punishment, with effect from 20 December 2021, for a term of office which will expire on 19 December 2025:
