MEMBERS' ATTENTION IS DRAWN TO:

- Electronic voting: votes in the plenary sittings (meeting in the hemicycle of the European Parliament) will be held using a nominative badge which will be distributed before the opening of the session to all representatives or duly designated substitutes who registered for the session before 13 March 2023. Votes in the committees and chambers (meeting in the Palais de l'Europe) will be held using the KUDO on-line application.
- Participants are reminded that access to the hemicycle is strictly limited to holders of badges which indicate the specific hemicycle symbol.
- The conditions and deadlines for tabling amendments (<u>congress.session@coe.int</u>): at the latest at **10.00**, **7 days before** the day when the texts to which they refer are to be discussed. Amendments must be signed by 5 delegates from at least two delegations for texts debated in plenary sittings or by five delegates from at least two national delegations sitting in a chamber for texts debated in that chamber.
- Registration of speakers : the registration of speakers for the debates should be done directly in Congress Connect or submitted to the Table Office Secretariat seated in front of the President's rostrum

- SPEAKING TIMES APPLIED IN THE DEBATES -Rule 30 paragraphs 6 and 7 of the Rules and Procedures of the Congress
- 6. Speaking time for delegates is limited as follows:
 - a. Single rapporteurs presenting reports: ten minutes;
 - b. Co-rapporteurs presenting reports: six minutes each;
 - c. Single rapporteurs replying to debates: five minutes;
 - d. Co-rapporteurs replying to debates: three minutes each;
 - e. Chairs of committees replying to debates (at their request): three minutes;

f. Other speakers (except on personal statements; on setting the agenda; on any procedural question or on amendments): three minutes;

g. Speakers on personal statements; on setting the agenda; on any procedural question or on amendments or subamendments: one minute.

7. When sufficient time is not available for all speakers to be heard for the times provided under Rule 30.6, the President may decide that speaking time will be reduced or that not all those who have entered their name in the register may speak.
