Subject: Request for Assistance in Receiving Compensation Awarded by the Court

Dear Registry of the European Court of Human Rights,

I am writing to seek your assistance regarding the execution of the judgment in the case of Saygozyyev and Goloshchapov v. Ukraine (Applications Nos. 39693/19 and 45218/22), delivered on 16 May 2024.

As a recognized Convention refugee currently residing in Austria, I am facing significant challenges in receiving the compensation awarded to me under the judgment. The Ukrainian Ministry of Justice has informed me that the funds can only be transferred to a bank account in Ukraine. Unfortunately, as I do not reside in Ukraine and am unable to open a Ukrainian bank account due to my current status, this requirement has created a serious obstacle to receiving the compensation.

In addition to this issue, I would like to express my concerns about the enforceability of the Court's judgment in Ukraine. As a signatory of the European Convention on Human Rights, I trust that Ukraine is obligated to implement and comply with the judgments handed down by this Court. However, the current situation leaves me in a position where

the compensation, despite the final judgment, remains inaccessible to me due to the conditions set by the Ukrainian authorities. I sincerely hope that the Ukrainian government respects the full legal force of this ruling and ensures its proper execution.

Considering my legal status as a refugee and my residence in Austria, I kindly request your guidance on how to resolve this issue. I believe that the transfer of the compensation to an Austrian bank account is both reasonable and necessary, as it would allow me to exercise my right to effective remedy and to receive the funds awarded to me in accordance with the Court's ruling.

I would also like to respectfully ask for your support in ensuring that the judgment is enforced in a manner that respects my circumstances, without requiring me to fulfill conditions that are not feasible due to my current residence outside of Ukraine.

If needed, I am happy to provide any further documentation or information to assist in this process.

Thank you for your attention to this important matter. I trust in the European Court of Human Rights' commitment to ensuring that its judgments are fully respected and executed, and I hope for a positive resolution of my situation.
