I. IDENTIFICATION

Date of Judgment: 6 March 2025

II. THE JUDGMENT

Summary description of the breach:

Violation of Article 3 of the Convention, concerning inadequate detention conditions the applicant was subjected to in Coimbra Prison for more than 1 year and 6 months. The inadequate conditions consisted along with other shortcomings, in the lack of personal space, lack of medical assistance and lack of or insufficient quantity of food.

Violation of Article 13 of the Convention, consisting of lack of any effective remedy in domestic law in respect of inadequate conditions of detention.

III. INDIVIDUAL MEASURES:

1. Payment of the sum awarded by way of just satisfaction:

Date: 20 May 2025 (see appendix 1).

Amount: 12.750 euros.
