Action Report: Information regarding A.L. and Others (application no. 45889/18) – clone case within the closed Strand Lobben and Others group of cases (application no. 37283/13)

The Government refers to the consolidated action plan 21 July 2025 and the e-mail 7 May 2026 from DG Execution with a request for information regarding any developments concerning the case of *A.L. and Others*.

As regards to A.L., the applicant had initiated proceedings before the District Court with the aim of re-establishing contact. The case was scheduled for a main hearing at the end of January 2026, and a supplementary report was obtained from a court-appointed expert. However, the child opposed all contact with the applicant, and her functioning deteriorated in the period leading up to the hearing, which was documented by the treating psychologist. On this basis, the applicant withdrew the claim, and the Board's decision of no contact remained in force.

There is nevertheless agreement that the child welfare services and the foster home will work towards a gradual re-establishment of contact, but progress is currently limited.

The Government invites the Committee to close its supervision of the execution of A.L.

As regards to general Measures, the relevant general measures were taken in the context of the execution of the leading case of *Strand Lobben and Others v Norway* (37283/13 – DH-DD(2025)726-rev). The case was closed by the adoption of Final Resolution CM/ResDH(2025)259 on 15/09/2025.

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
