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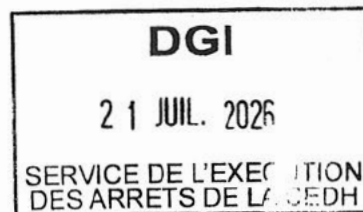

My name is Zsolt Lázár. The European Court of Human Rights ("ECtHR"), acting upon my application (no. 32906/21. Lázár v. Hungary) on 4 July 2024 delivered a final judgment ruling that because of the number of years that I would have to serve of my life sentence before becoming eligible for release on parole; my punishment violates Article 3 of the Convention for the protection of Human Rights and Fundamental Freedoms ("the Convention").

The Office of the Prosecutor General of Hungary submitted a motion (Bf. 217/2025/8.) to the Curia (the highest level court of Law in Hungary) to leave my sentence unchanged.

On 2 June 2026, the Curia uphold my sentence; including its provision of my having to serve more than twenty-five years before eligibility for a parole hearing. (Decree no. Bfv. II. 237/2026/13.)

The State of Hungary, though a signatory party to the Convention, by failing to correct my prison sentence to make it comply with

Article 3, has thus not been executing a final judgment of the
ECHR since 4 July 2024.

I am asking the Hon. Department to expedite the execution of
the final ECHR judgment in my case.
