The European Committee of Social Rights is established by the European Social Charter. It is composed of 15 independent experts. It works on two specific objectives: treating collective Origin/DG Remarks complaints and examining national reports on the application of the European Social Charter with a view to rule on the conformity of national situations under the Charter.

- To examine the pending collective complaints.
- To examine national reports for Conclusions 2025 (revised Charter) and Conclusions XXIII-1 (2025) (1961 Charter)
- To examine developments relating to the procedure on nonaccepted provisions (Implementation of Article 22 of the 1961 Charter).

Objective(s)

- To examine state reports on follow-up to decisions in collective complaints.
- To discuss the Evaluation report on the European Social Charter.
- To exchange on preparations for the 2026 High-level Conference on the European Social Charter.

Output

- 1) The Committee adopted a decision on admissibility in the following complaint:
 - International Movement ATD Fourth World v. Spain Complaint No. 241/2024
- 2) The Committee examined national reports for Conclusions 2025 (revised Charter) and Conclusions XXIII-1 (2025) (1961 Charter).
- 3) The Committee examined state reports on follow-up to decisions in collective complaints.
- 4) The Committee examined developments relating to the procedure on non-accepted provisions and adopted its report in respect of Hungary and the United Kingdom.
