It works on two specific objectives: treating collective complaints and examining national reports on the application of the European Social Charter with a view to rule on the conformity of national situations under the Charter.

- To examine the pending collective complaints.
 - To examine national reports for Conclusions 2025 (revised Charter) and Conclusions XXIII-1 (2025) (1961 Charter)
 - To examine developments relating to the procedure on non-accepted provisions (Implementation of Article 22 of the 1961 Charter).
 - To examine state reports on follow-up to decisions in collective complaints.
 - To discuss the Evaluation report on the European Social Charter.
 - To exchange on preparations for the 2026 High-level Conference on the European Social Charter.
