





READI WORKSHOP ON CYBERRIME LEGISLATION IN ASEAN MEMBER STATES

- First workshop in Kuala Lumpur on 27-28 November 2008 and the second workshop in Manila on 26-28 January 2010.
- Establishment of ASEAN Training Network on Cybercrime
- To leverage on CoE's expertise in developing appropriate training module.

JUDICIAL TRAINING

- To train and provide necessary knowledge to judges and prosecutors to prosecute cases of cybercrime and those involving electronic evidence.
- ILKAP is one of the two such training centres in ASEAN and was established in 23 December 1993
- Main objective of ILKAP is to enhance the competency, effectiveness and professionalism of judicial, legal and law enforcement officers by providing systematic, relevant and progressive training
- Have introduced new syllabus on cybercrime

CYBERCRIME LEGISLATION COURSE (2010 and 2011)

- The training is a collaborative effort between MCMC, Judicial and Legal Training Institute (ILKAP) and CoE
- Initiated in 2010 for only Malaysian participants and in 2011 opened for other participants from ASEAN
- 26 participants in 2010 and 30 participants in 2011 and was also joined by participants from Thailand and Vietnam.
- Training to be an annual program with more participation from ASEAN member countries.

TRAINING MODULE

- Modeled after CoE Project on Cybercrime: Cybercrime training for judges and prosecutors
- CoE provided strong support in facilitating the training by providing expert speakers
- Also were assisted by US Department of Justice, Malaysian Judicial and Legal Service and Royal Malaysian Police

INTERNATIONAL COLLABORATION

Interface with international bodies and organizations to enhance cooperation and exchange of information, expertise and intelligence.
