Launch of the French online reporting tool Pointdecontact.net

Established in **1998** by the French Internet Service Providers Association to help fight against **child pornography** and **racism** on the Internet;

Funded by the European Commission since **2000** under successive "Safer Internet "programs;

From 2004, a legal obligation for ISPs to provide an online form enabling Internet users to report illegal content, and to forward such content to competent authorities;

In parallel, signature by AFA members of a « Charter against odious content »;

Part of the "French Safer Internet Centre" since 2009, supported by the EC and consisting of an awareness program (Internet Sans Crainte) and a "helpline" for young people (Net Ecoute).

CLICK, REPORT!

Point de Contact field of competence:

- Child sexual abuse material
- Incitement to racial hatred
- Offensive content accessible to children.
- Praise of war crimes or crimes against humanity
- Crimes and offences against people
- Incitement to terrorism or bomb-making
- Provocation to suicide



Website Mobile Website Software (for computer)












POINT DE CONTACT VIDEO – REPORTING ILLEGAL CONTENT







Point de Contact daily activities

When received, reports are assessed and content traced in order to locate its source:

For content hosted in France:



- ➤ Report is forwarded to the relevant French ISP, and simultaneously to the French Law Enforcement Agency (Central Office against Cybercrime, OCLCTIC);
- > Time span for take down is usually quite short (a couple of hours).

For content hosted abroad:




- In case of URLs leading to Child Sexual Abuse Images, the report is transmitted to the relevant INHOPE (International Association of Internet Hotlines) hotline, through the INHOPE URL Database;
- ➤ In all cases, reports are transmitted to the French LEA, which then forwards them to INTERPOL.

Reporters are always informed of the content assessment and the actions taken by the hotliners if they indicate their email address in the reporting form.















What data can we operate with the Point de Contact Backoffice (1)
