



Danube Delta was designated as a Biosphere Reserve in 1990 by the "Man and Biosphere" (MAB) Programme of UNESCO and, one year later, was inscribed on the Ramsar List of the Convention on wetlands of international importance especially as waterfowl habitat and on the UNESCO World Heritage Convention's List, as a natural world heritage site.

Danube Delta Biosphere Reserve received in 2000, for the first time, the European Diploma for Protected Areas, awarded by the Council of Europe, under the Bern Convention. Therefore 2015 is a very important year, both for Europe and for us, being an anniversary year: 50 years of European Diploma for Protected Areas and 25 years of Danube Delta Biosphere Reserve.
