**1. "Open Day" to the data subjects in the premises of the Commissioner's Office for Personal Data Protection in Tirana**

This activity contributed in raising the awareness on personal data protection issues among a large number of Albanian citizens. During the Open Day the data subjects had the chance to be informed about its rights and the ways to protect it. Also the public had the opportunity to obtain legal advice as well as educational advice and informational materials. Also possibilities were given to the public to be informed about the 28 January and its importance.

**2. Awareness raising activity in a private University with the law students.**

The DP Authority organized this event in cooperation with the University's Dean Office in order to raise the awareness on data protection among the Albanian youth. The Commissioner held a speech about the data protection issues, the importance of the 28 January and also made an overview on the DP Office's 5 year working period. A discussion occurred with the students, who posed different questions and got responses by the Commissioner's staff. Also a picture collection on privacy topic owned by the Commissioner's office was shown in an exhibition in the university's hall.

**3. Photo contest "Think about Privacy" in a public primary school.**

The DP Authority organised in cooperation with the Primary school's directorate a picture competition on the topic "Think about Privacy". Several pupils participated with their pictures taken by cameras in this event and showed to Commissioner's and school directorate's staff. At the end of the activity to all the pupils different visibility materials like hat, t-shirts, pencils, bags, leaflets etc were distributed.

#### 4. Broadcasting the two spots on Data Protection issue

In the occasion of 28 January 2013, in order to draw the attention of the public on data protection field and the rights of the data subjects, two spots on Data Protection issue owned by the Commissioner's Office were broadcasted for several times on SCAN Radio Television. The message transmitted by this two spots before, on and after the 28 January had a strong impact in raising the awareness on data protection among Albanian public.
