#### Denial of service (DOS) attacks

DOS attacks are attempts to render a computer system unavailable to users often by bombarding the target computer on network with communication requests

#### Distributed Denial of Service (DDOS) attacks

DDOS attacks occur when many computers bombard a target computer or network with communication requests such as emails or queries.
