List of Decisions

The European Committee on Crime Problems (CDPC), meeting in Strasbourg under the Chairmanship of Mr Lorenzo Salazar, decided:

1. Opening of the meeting

- to take note of the opening address of Mr Jan Kleijssen, Director of the Information Society and Action against Crime Directorate, Directorate General of Human Rights and Rule of Law, on the most recent developments in the Council of Europe, in particular the priorities of the current and former Armenian and Andorran Chairmanships respectively, relevant to the work of the CDPC.

7. Promotion of the Integrity of Sport against the Manipulation of Results, notably match-fixing

b. Feasibility of an Additional Protocol to the Council of Europe Criminal Law Convention on Corruption (ETS No. 173)

- to take note of the replies received by delegations from the CDPC and/or the GRECO to the questionnaire concerning the issue of the feasibility of an Additional Protocol to the Council of Europe Criminal Law Convention on Corruption (ETS No. 173) and of the document prepared by the Secretariat summarising all these replies;
- to agree, in particular, with its conclusions that “in the majority of countries that replied (...) corrupt practices in the non-profit sector are covered by existing legislation” ;
- to come to the conclusion that there is no need for such a protocol;
- to instruct the Secretariat to inform the GRECO about this decision with a view to jointly transmitting this response to the CM.
