L' APCE élit Paulo Sérgio Pinto de Albuquerque à la Cour européenne des droits de l'homme au

Strasbourg, 25.01.2011 - L'Assemblée parlementaire d (APCE), qui se réunit cette semaine à Strasbourg en session plénière, a élu aujourd'hui Paulo Sérgio Pinto de Albuquerque droits de l'homme au titre du Portugal.

M. de Albuquerque, ayant obtenu une majorité absolue des suffrages exprimés, est élu juge à la Cour européenne des Droits de l'Homme; son mandat commence après le 5 février. Les juges sont trois candidats présentée par chacun des Etats ayant ratifié la Convention européenne des droits de l'homme.

PACE elects Paulo Sérgio Pinto de Albuquerque judge of the European Court of Human Rights in respect of Portugal

Strasbourg, 25.01.2011 - The Parliamentary Assembly of the Council of Europe (PACE), meeting this week in plenary session in Strasbourg, today elected Paulo Sérgio Pinto de Albuquerque as judge to the European Court of Human Rights in respect of Portugal.

Mr de Albuquerque, having obtained an absolute majority of votes cast, is elected a judge of the European Court of Human Rights for a term of office of nine years starting after 5 February 2011. Judges are elected by PACE from a list of three candidates nominated by each State which has ratified the European Convention on Human Rights.
