Conference on Constitutional Aspects of the Judicial Reform in Ukraine

Dates: 24 and 25 March 2011

Place: Lviv (Ukraine)

Organised by the Council of Europe and the European Union within the framework of the Joint Programme entitled "Transparency and Efficiency of the Judicial System of Ukraine" (TEJSU Project) and the USAID Ukraine Rule of Law Project, in co-operation with the Lviv National University.

Description: Aimed at supporting the constitutional reform process, the conference will focus on the challenges of the Constitution of Ukraine with respect to European standards in the field of justice. The Constitutional Court of Ukraine, the High Council of Justice, the Supreme Court of Ukraine, the High Specialised Court in criminal and civil matters and the High Administrative Court will also be represented.
