Proposal for a Directive on copyright in the Digital Single Market

Focus on rights' licensing on VOD platforms

- Copyright package
- → New negotiation mechanism (Art. 10)
- → Conditions of functioning and bearing of costs set at national level (Recital 30)

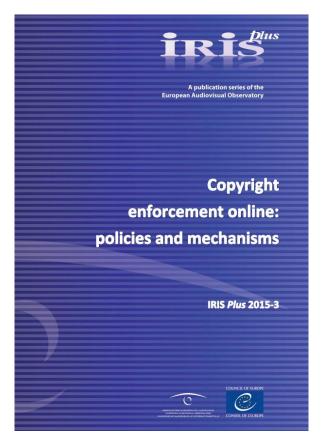


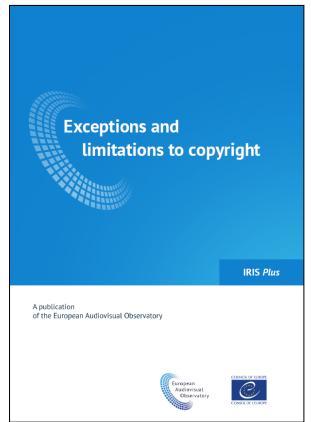

Regulations on portability and online retransmission



- Regulation on portability
- → cross-border portability of online audiovisual content services in the internal market

- Regulation on geo-blocking
- → audiovisual services are left out of the scope

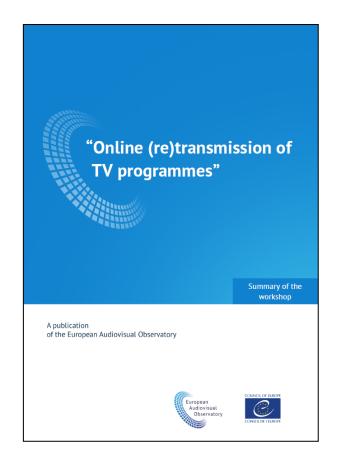




- Regulation on online retransmission
- → Broadcasters: application of the country of origin principle to the clearing of rights for ancillary online services (Art. 2)
- → Digital retransmission of TV/radio: mandatory collective management of rights to retransmission over "closed" networks (Art. 3)
