



From ENPI CBC MED (2007-2013) to Interreg NEXT MED (2021-2027)

- Interreg NEXT MED is the **third edition** of the largest EU-funded programme for cooperation between the two shores of the Mediterranean;
- It builds on the experience accumulated by **80 ENI CBC MED** projects and **95 ENPI CBC MED** projects as well as **more than 1.300 project partners.**
- Contribute to **joint prosperity**, **stability** and **security** by addressing together **common challenges**;


