

# **A HELP course with specificities**



Council of Europe

Conseil de l'Éurope

- Primary developed for legal and health professionals
- Approach adapted to multidisciplinary audience
- Developed considering that it will also be used by university students





# Methodology

- Takes into account the heavy time pressure imposed on professionals in their daily work
  - Practical approach
    - Iinking theory and practices enabling a more dynamic approach of principles through concrete examples








# Methodology

- Online courses are developed and adapted on a tailor-made basis, meeting participants' specific training needs and learning pace, allowing flexibility
  - Pedagogical approach
    - clarifying key legal as well as scientific notions through glossary and interviews
    - enabling choices on course modules
    - providing link to resources to go more in depth in the analysis
    - basis for multidisciplinary exercise
