

# **ACTIVITY RESULTS FOR 2021**

Operational since 1989, **Eurimages** is the Council of Europe's fund for the support of the international co-production, distribution and exhibition of cinematographic works. As of December 2021, the Fund comprised 40 countries. The Fund is governed by a Board of Directors composed of the national representatives of the Member States. Since 1 January 2017, this committee has been chaired by Catherine Trautmann.

# PARTNERSHIPS WITH FESTIVALS

Due to the pandemic which continued to impact the film industry, Eurimages had a reduced physical presence at the Cannes Film Festival in July and the Fund did not hold its usual reception. The Eurimages team also attended the Venice Film Festival without having a stand or contributing to the closing reception of the Gap Financing Market. Sponsorship activities were maintained, with the exception of the participation of Eurimages in the Meetings on the Bridge of the Istanbul Festival which was cancelled as the event to be sponsored could not take place, due to the exclusively digital edition of this event.



#### PERSPECTIVES

- The Eurimages Secretariat, in conjunction with the Fund's Board of Management, prepared the implementation of the reform of the fund's governance throughout the year so that the core aspects of the reform (revised governance structure and changed decision-making process) could come into force in January 2022.
- An audiovisual policy advisor was seconded in early 2021 by the Romanian authorities to develop a project on TV series co-production within the Eurimages Secretariat. The conference "Preserving independent production, diversity and pluralism of TV series in Europe" (Budapest, 30/09-01/10 2021) initiated a process that will continue in 2022. The Steering Committee for Culture, Heritage and Landscape decided in December 2021 to set up a working group of experts to assess the feasibility of a legal instrument for European series and, if necessary, to elaborate it possibly in the form of a convention that would take into account recent technological and financial developments in the European film and series industry.
- In Spring 2021, the Fund set up a Sustainability Study Group with the participation of members of the Board of Management and specialists in environmental protection or green film production. The group met 4 times in 2021 and developed a sustainability strategy for the Fund which was adopted by the Board of Management in December 2021. The Study Group will continue its work in 2022 to develop concrete measures that can be implemented quickly, mainly within the co-production support programme.
