REPORTS BY PARTIES - CROATIA

Habitat Directive

- Croatia made its first national report according to article 17 of Habitat Directive in 2019. Unfortunately, for most of herpetofauna species the status was unknown.
- National Monitoring project a development of monitoring programmes for more than 40 species of amphibians and reptiles also includes resources for testing those programmes and for collecting new data.

National management plans

- Management plan for *Mauremys rivulata* (endangered species in Croatia) is prepared in 2021 end plan should be adopted by the end of this year.
- National management plans for other species of interest (e.g. Rana latastei, Vipera amodytes): at his point, we do not have management plans at national levels for species like this (that are geographically restricted). The aim is to develop make management plans for NATURA 2000 sites (project "Development of Natura 2000 Management Framework") where mentioned species are target species.
- Draft management plan for olm Proteus anguinus (endangered species in Croatia) is prepared

Protected area

One **new protected area** dedicated for the protection of *Mauremys rivulata* - Herpetological reserve - Majkovi.

IAS

- For two invasive alien species (Herpestes javanicus and Trachemys scripta) that have a negative impact on herpetofauna in Croatia, the national management plans are developed. Every plan describes the methodology for IAS control and eradication on a specific location.
- IAS mapping was performed before making plans. According to the results of mapping, small Indian mongoose covers an area of almost 1800 km2 and *Trachemys scripta* was recorded at 126 localities.
