Aim and objectives of the Online Study Session on Education and Training of Youth Workers in Europe Today

Aim: To empower youth workers and youth work educators to engage in the creation of frameworks for education and training for youth workers, based on the Council of Europe's Recommendation on Youth Work and the European Youth Work Agenda.

Objectives:

1. To present and explore different practices and current developments in youth work education, both formal and non-formal, as well as the policy frameworks in Europe, including the Council of Europe's Recommendation on Youth Work.

2. To understand the possibilities for development of youth work education based on the conclusions of the European Youth Work Convention 2020

3. To explore the European Youth Work Portfolio, as well as other youth work education materials, such as the T-kit series and the work of the "Expert group on researching education and career paths of youth workers"

4. To create an enabling space for peer-learning and exchange of best practices on youth work education.

5. To develop action plans on education and training of youth workers which will guide the advocacy and programmes of ECYC member organisations at local, regional or national level.
