SCOPE & PURPOSE

This Resource Bank is based on a secure and confidential online platform. It contains relevant national information related to Controlled Deliveries. By clicking a specific country on the world map, authorized personnel from participating states gain direct access to restricted country information including legal basis, responsible authorities and access to national 24/7 SPOC in real-time. These resources are aimed at enabling fast and secure action to conduct a controlled delivery between countries in a highly efficient and secure way.

FUNCTIONALITY

The Resource Bank has restricted access following an application and vetting procedure. Information and content is generated from input by participating countries that is regularly updated by submitting member States, and based on reviews of existing manuals on Controlled Deliveries.

THE PARTNERSHIP

The Resource Bank is hosted by the Council of Europe's Pompidou Group in cooperation with Europol, Eurojust, Interpol, OSCE, SELEC and in coordination with the Council of Europe's Expert Committee on the operation of European conventions on co-operation in criminal matters.

ACCESS & JOINING

Access to the Resource Bank is reserved to participating countries. Applications can be lodged from any interested national government to ensure as wide as possible coverage. Joining only requires filling in the questionnaire that will be sent to collect country relevant information. After receiving the completed countries' questionnaire from the relevant authorities, access to the Resource Bank will be granted. Competent authorities are the designated judicial authorities and law enforcement agencies that are members of the partnering international organisations hosting the Resource Bank.
