- Mission: protection of **human rights** through enhanced **capacities of justice professionals** (HELP courses)
- Optimise HELP online courses: + national versions
- Keep geographical / topical projects:

 - Western Balkans and Turkey*
 - Russia
 - Expanding coverage in CoE MS (e.g. EaP) and beyond (i.e. South Mediterranean*, Central Asia*)
 - HELP radicalisation prevention / Fight against Terrorism / ICCM*
 HELP component in CoE Action Plans, i.e. migration

HELP e-courses and e-Platform

Optimise existing (38) courses on HR topics –very few new ones:

(e.g. HR in armed forces, Interplay ECHR-EUCFR, additional module (VaW), CEPEJ?

Updates of courses (European Standards: ECHR + CoE Conventions, EU Charter +EU laws & case-law of ECtHR & CJEU)

Further promote/Develop + national versions adding national law & case-law

Support 7 and use of self-study (from 46,000 March 90,000 March 2021)

National Training Institutions, Bar associations encouraged to integrate courses

HELP Methodology

Ensure coherent & flexible application of the HELP methodology (HELP Guidebook), further engagement of HELP trainers, mainstreaming of HELP ToT

HELP to adapt to A demand of self-learning

National Training Institutions, Bar associations can benefit from +600 HELP trainers, including those with ECtHR experience


