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I - INTRODUCTION

Annual Advisory Forum

The Annual Advisory Forum of the Cultural Routes of the Council of Europe addresses trends and challenges in relation to the Cultural Routes and provides a platform for an exchange of experience and good practices, and review of progress with the implementation of the Cultural Routes programme of activities. It allows for the exchange of new professional practices and represents and ideal opportunity to launch new initiatives and develop partnerships.

The 11th Annual Advisory Forum on Cultural Routes of the Council of Europe will take place on 5-7 October 2022 in Chania (Crete), Greece.

The 2022 Advisory Forum is organised by the Enlarged Partial Agreement on Cultural Routes of the Council of Europe and the European Institute of Cultural Routes, the Hellenic Ministry of Culture and Sports, the Hellenic Ministry of Tourism, the Greek National Tourism Organization, the Region of Crete, the Municipality of Chania, the Chambers of Industry and Commerce of Chania, and the Historic Cafes Route.

A bit of history. . .

Once Minoan, Roman, Byzantine, Venetian, Ottoman, Chania is a remarkable small city by the Cretan Sea, rich of history and myths. The city of Chania is built on the site of the ancient Kydonia, one of the most important cities of Crete according to Homer. The archaeological remains of Kydonia are visible today and allow us to contemplate impressive testimonies of the Mycenaean era.

The atmosphere has a touch of Florence and Venice, combined with the culture and character of Cretan people and traditions. The harbour of Chania is a true gem and gives travellers and inhabitants alike some beautiful sceneries to be savoured throughout the day.

The Municipality of Chania is one of the most visited in Crete thanks to its rich heritage of significant archaeological importance and of the many well-preserved monuments in and around the city, testimonies of the rich history of Chania. One of the most significant archaeological sites that is being preserved is the archaeological site of Kastelli, where you will be able to admire the ruins of the ancient Kydonia, the ancient Aptera and Intzedin castle.

i. Crafts and delicacies

Chania has a very rich cultural tradition. The Cretan traditions are expressed in the local crafts (weaving, carpets, towels, etc.) and through the local communities, such as the women who preserve the traditional silk and wool embroideries.

In Chania, you can also find many workshops in ceramics, woodcarving and metallurgy, which allow you to better understand the process of making local crafts. One of the most celebrated craft is that of the Cretan boot-making (called Stivania) which visitors can admire in Skridlof Street, in the old city of Chania. Cretan knife-making with engraved traditional Cretan couplets is also very famous in Chania.

Chania has a very rich traditional gastronomic heritage, mixing traditional Greek and Cretan flavours. Some of the most famous Cretan dishes are: Dakos, a popular Cretan starter made with dried barley bread slices topped with fresh tomatoes and feta or creamy mizithra cheese and olive oil and oregano. Other famous dishes are Sfakia Pie, Kalitsounia, Chochlioi Boubouristi (Fried Snails) and many more. Crete is also known for its wine. The best way to discover Chania's gastronomy is to go to the market and try some fresh food and specialties.

ii. Beaches

Chania is located on the coast of the Cretan Sea and is famous for its remarkable beaches with golden sand and crystal-clear blue water. Visitors can find beaches in Chania equipped with sun beds, umbrellas, and offering high quality services such as water sports, restaurants, taverns and cafe bars. There are also wild beaches in the surroundings of the city for a more natural experience.

Within the geographical borders of the Municipality of Chania, there are 11 beaches that have been awarded the Blue Flag, an exemplary environmental quality label: Stalos, Agii Apostoli 1, Agii Apostoli 2, Chrissi Akti, Agia Marina, Kalamaki, Nea Chora, Marathi, Stavros, Agios Onoufrios, and Kalathas.
