# **THREE PHASES OF MARTIAL LAW**

Mobilization of all resources for the recovery of Ukraine. Formation of a unified approach of the state to the implementation of measures to rebuild settlements and regions in general affected by the armed aggression of the Russian Federation

## PERIOD OF COMBAT



Phase I. Functioning in martial law

■ Conducting martial law (macrofinancial stabilization, assistance to victims, execution of defence orders)

Monitoring of destruction Restoration of damaged critical infrastructure

Transformation of territorial authorities in the conditions of war (formation of RMA, DMA and MA)

Preparation of package decisions of the authorities for the postwar period

Establishment of Ukraine's **Restoration Funds** 

**Phase II. Reconstruction** after the end of hostilities

- Implementation of the economic model of the postwar period (transitional economic model)
- supervision of the use of funds

- Reconstruction of destroyed basic infrastructure (water, energy, heat, public services)
- Reconstruction of housing stock

Restoration of the system of territorial organization of power (amendments to the Constitution to strengthen the LG)

Launch of priority reforms

Cooperation with international financial institutions on the implementation of the "Marshall Plan"
