PRIORITIES AND **NEEDS**

THREE PHASES OF MARTIAL LAW

Mobilization of all resources for the recovery of Ukraine. Formation of a unified approach of the state to the implementation of measures to rebuild settlements and regions in general affected by the armed aggression of the Russian Federation

PERIOD OF COMBAT

RECOVERY PERIOD

1-2 years

up to 10 years

Phase I. Functioning in martial law

- **Conducting martial law** (macro-financial stabilization, assistance to victims, execution of defence orders)
- **Monitoring of destruction**
- Restoration of **damaged critical infrastructure**
- **Transformation of territorial authorities** in the conditions of war (formation of RMA, DMA and MA)
- **Preparation of package decisions** of the authorities for the postwar period
- **Establishment of Ukraine's Restoration Funds**

Phase II. Reconstruction after the end of hostilities

ECONOMY

- **Implementation of the economic model** of the postwar period (transitional economic model)
- **Unconditional funding** of priority needs / proper supervision of the use of funds

CONSTRUCTION

- **Reconstruction of destroyed basic infrastructure** (water, energy, heat, public services)
- **Reconstruction of housing stock**

TERRITORIAL ORGANIZATION OF GOVERNMENT

- **Restoration of the system of territorial organization of power** (amendments to the Constitution to strengthen the LG)

REFORMS

- **Launch of priority reforms**

INTERNATIONAL COOPERATION

- **Cooperation with international financial institutions** on the implementation of the "Marshall Plan"

Phase III. Implementation of the "Marshall Plan"

- **Conducting a "green" economy** of sustainable development (economic growth combined with environmental sustainability)

- **Complex development of territories,** development of modern urban complexes

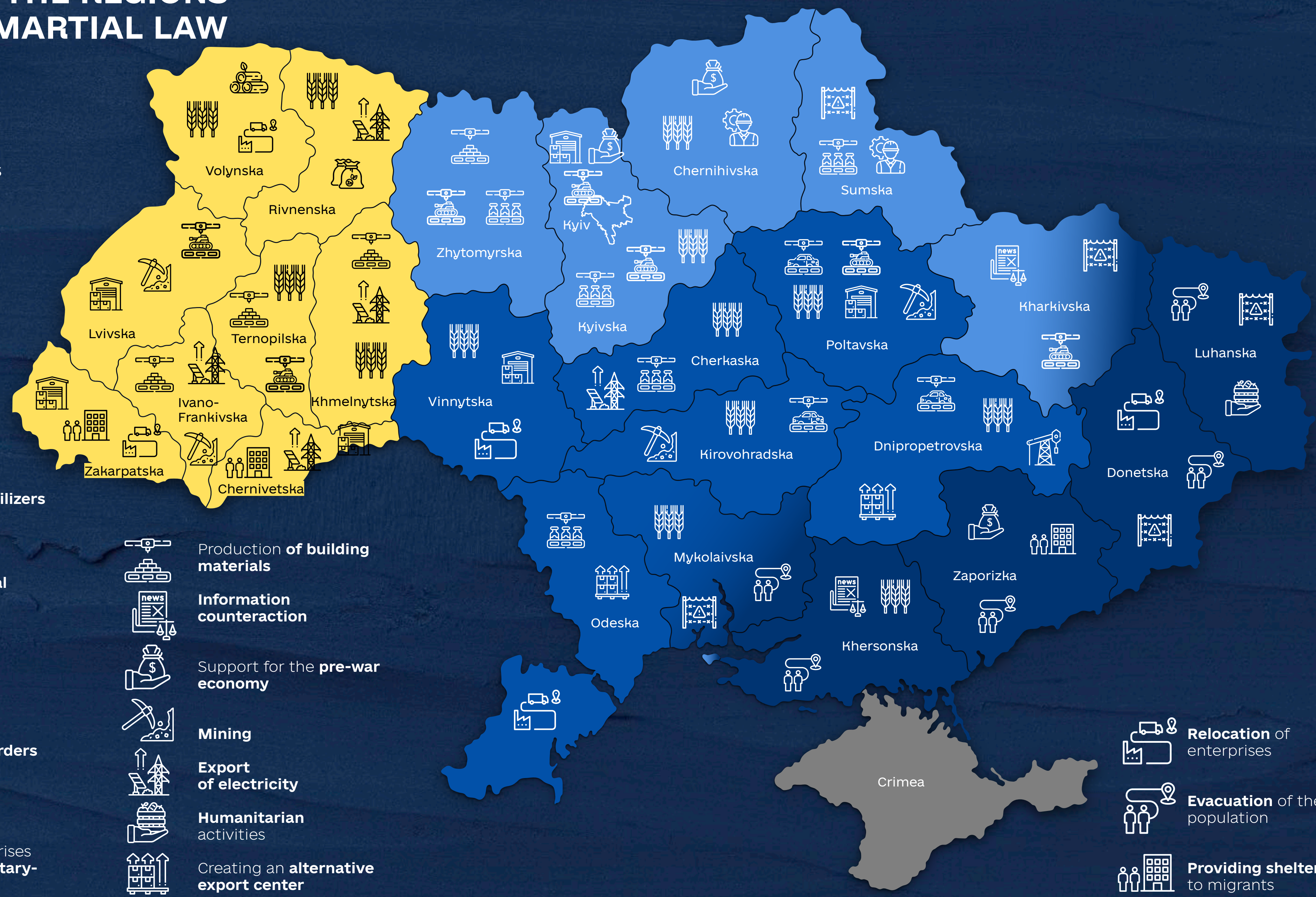
- **Transformation of the system of territorial organization** of authority in accordance with the amendments to the Constitution

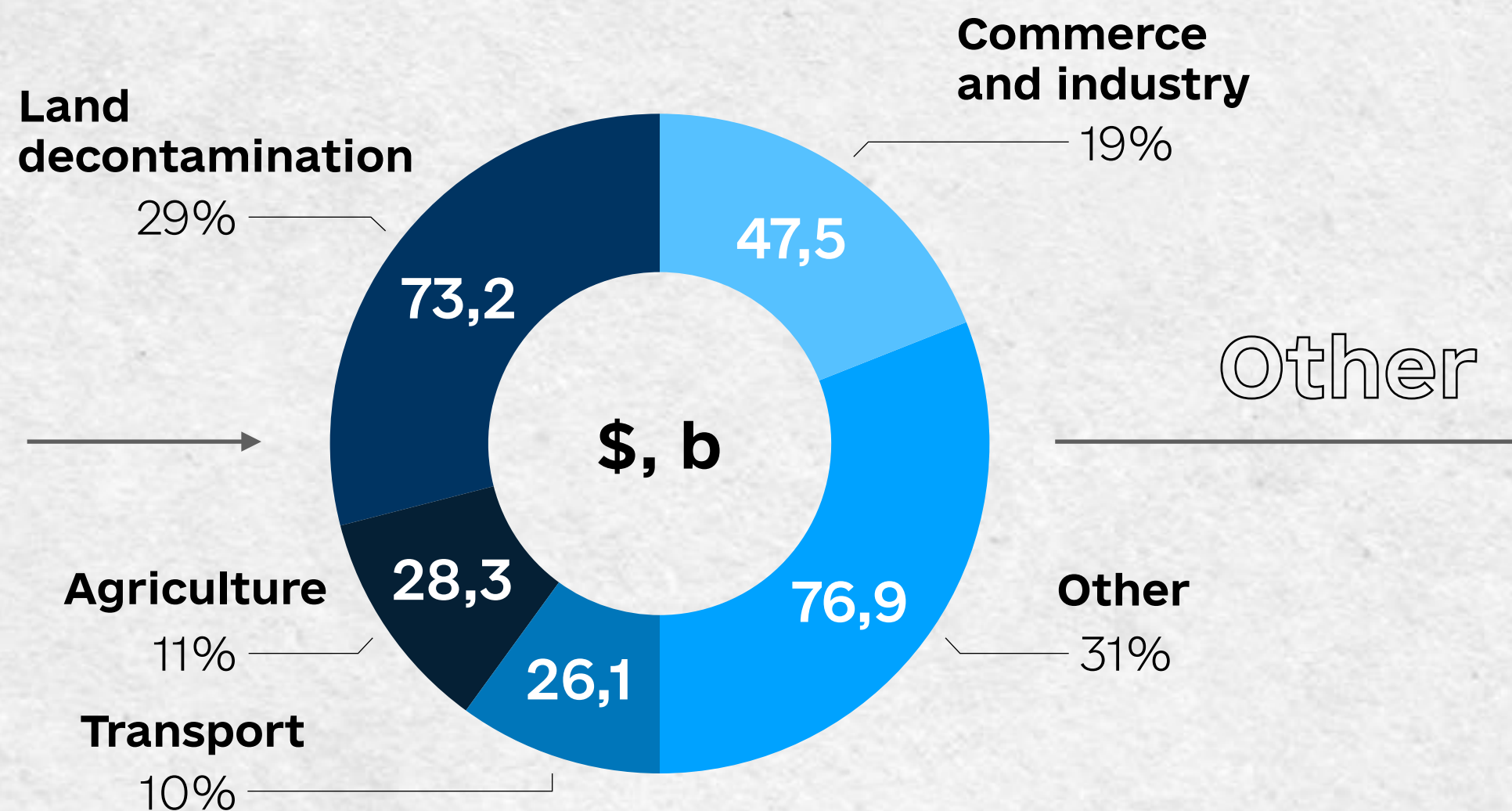

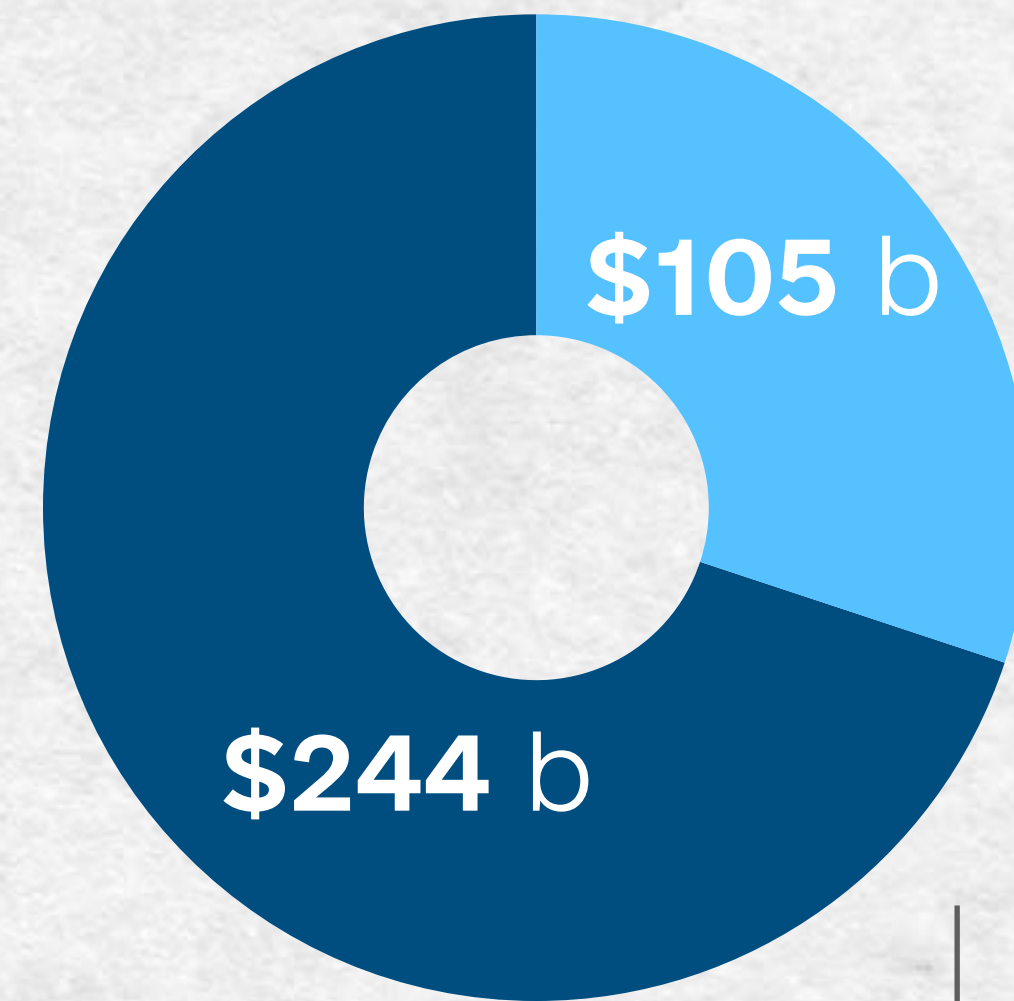

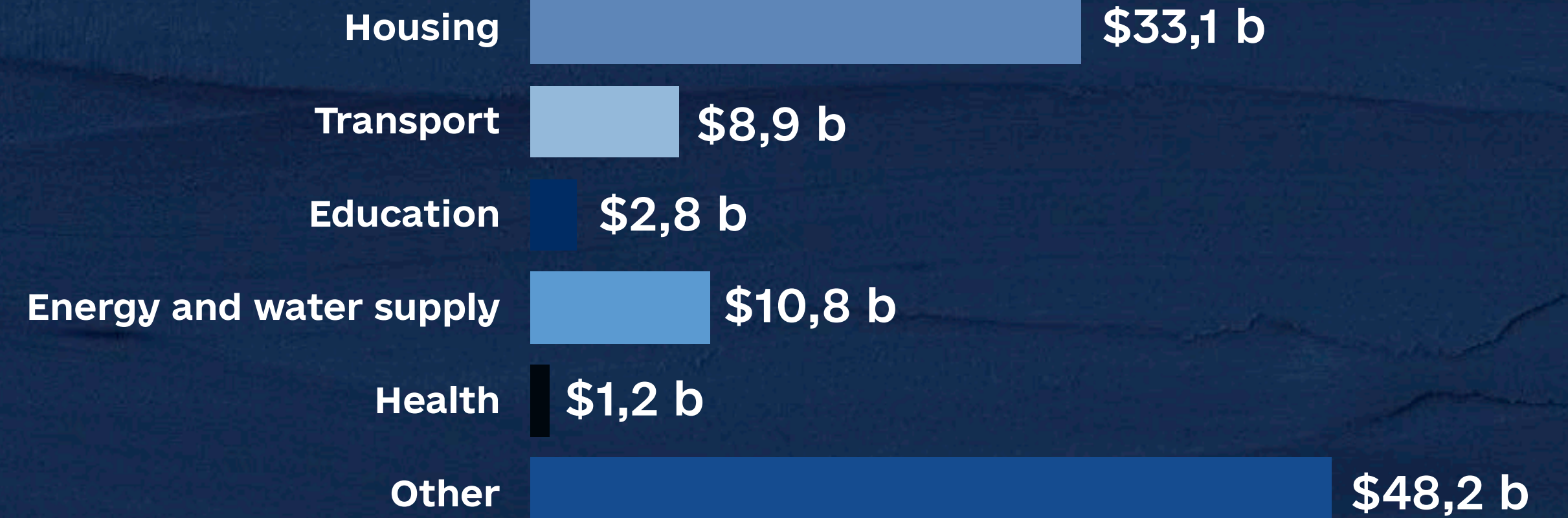

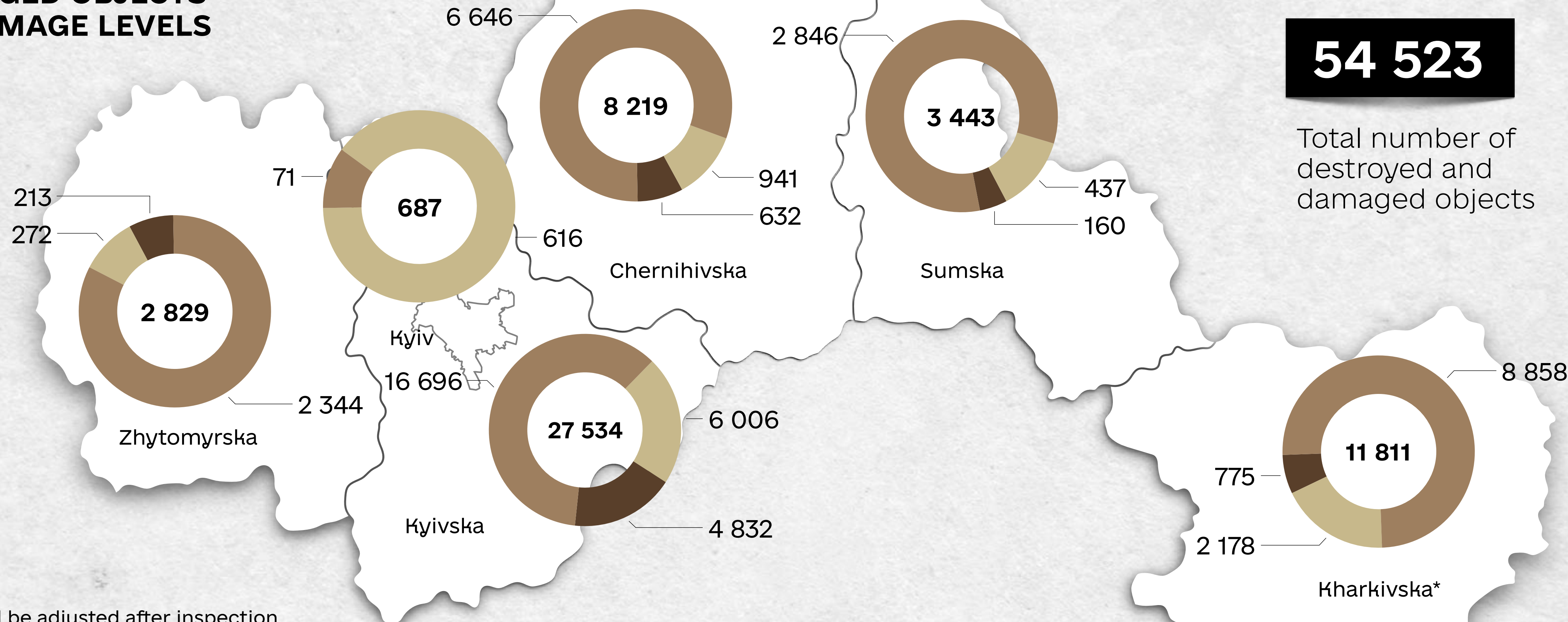


