Aim and objectives of the study session "YOUTH WORK FOR ALL: DEFINING SOCIAL INCLUSION FROM POLICY TO REALITY"

The aim

To develop a deeper understanding of social inclusion and be able to advocate for social inclusion in youth work in participants' own contexts

Objectives:
