Aim and objectives of the study session "Youth Democracy Academy"

Aim: Equip the participants with knowledge and skills to implement the "Educate for democracy" programme in their local realities.

Objectives:

a) to further develop young people's sense of critical thinking and skills for information analysis and fact checking,

b) to bring young people closer and discuss their approach to existing challenges and threats to democracy Europe is going through, such as a lack of social bonds and solidarity, a generalised sense of insecurity, growing populism and misinformation and environmental challenges,
