


Creating <u>a brand new European Cultural Route from Flanders</u>, <u>Belgium to the Baldwin Tower in the city of Veliko Tarnovo, Bulgaria</u> Objective



- * establishing a cooperation platform between tourism stakeholders to support sustainable, culturally-aware and inclusive tourism based on transboundary partnership;
- harnessing the collective potential of the shared cultural heritage, and thus, in the long run, becoming a powerful marketing tool for the involved states;
- * giving a shared identity to cultural heritage that has previously been promoted independently;
- * establishing the sites along the route as prime tourist destinations;
- ***** expansion of the Cultural Routes network.

The Latin Emperor Baldwin I was captured by the Bulgarian Tsar Kaloyan after the Battle of Edirne in 1205, and was imprisoned and died in a tower of the Tsarevets fortress of the medieval Bulgarian capital Veliko Tarnovo.

Tsar Kaloyan wrote to Pope Innocent III, reporting that Baldwin had died in prison.



Leonardo's journey from Rome to Amboise (1516) projected onto the Geographical Table of the Gaules by Jean Boisseau (1645)



Within the panorama of European culture, Niccolò Paganini played a decisive role, not only in the field of music, but also as an expression of a historical era of great changes, which led to the establishment of a new **European citizenship**, between the 18th and 19th centuries. Always in contact with other great composers and musicians of his time, in various European countries, performing in major theatres, he consolidated this vision of a unique European artist, whose fame is still very much alive today, an **inspiration** for younger **generations**, in and beyond the field of music.

Introduction





All of the journeys made by Paganini were documented on the basis of his correspondence and other authentic documents, as well as the concert programmes and can be followed by the travellers. In particular, the stages of his memorable tour from 1828 to 1834, throughout Europe, spanning countries, over 20,000 kilometres, performing over 400 concerts, many for charity. By visiting these places, the contemporary traveller can follow artistic, cultural, educational and academic activities offered, theatres and historical centres in numerous European cities to experience and discover one of the most eclectic and brilliant musicians of all time.







1431 Pietro Querini, a Venetian merchant who did his businesses by sea routes from Greece to Flanders.

On one of his journey, he was shipwrecked in the North Sea, but fortunately survived and found a safe place on the island of Røst in Lofoten. The locals took in Querini and the rest of his crew and taught them their customs and traditions. In 1432, Pietro Querini returned to Venice by land, crossing Europe taking with him the «gold of the island»: the stockfish and the new routes.
