






Q.5 Number of annual seminars attended since 2018?






Q.9 Are equality bodies of Council of Europe member states adequately represented in ECRI's annual seminars?






Q.11 how inclusive and respectful of diversity is the participation of equality body representatives in ECRI's annual seminars? (national background,
