




The companies and proffesionals operate with data-forms, and they get in return guided processing, a general view of the case, interaction with courts....



Providing managers with quality information to improve tactical and operational decision making.






DATA LABORATORY




Generative AI – Plain language summaries – Justice Folder for citizens and professionals




Generative AI – Text 2 Speech and subtitles


