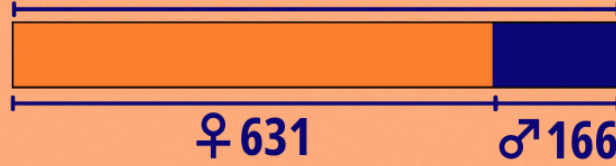


Serbian civil society received support in its efforts to raise awareness on the **Istanbul Convention**

In Ukraine, **300+** civil society representatives, local government officials, internally displaced persons and LGBTQIA+ individuals (at least 50% women) were **empowered to advocate for gender equality**



250 legal professionals in Bosnia and Herzegovina trained in **investigating and prosecuting digital and sexual violence against women**

19 representatives from 10 universities in the Eastern Partnership were guided in **gender mainstreaming law school curricula**

31 mentors built their capacity to provide fellow legal professionals with crucial **mentoring** on **Women's Access to Justice** in the Western Balkans

98% of Turkish university students (♀ 317, ♂ 72) following training on gender-sensitive, victim-oriented legal services reported improvement in knowledge and skills

In Armenia, awareness-raising campaigns challenging **harmful gender stereotypes** and **promoting equality** reached

more than 300,000 viewers

Key legal reform advice followed in Azerbaijan **protecting girls from early cohabitation and marriage** and ensuring state-funded legal aid for victims of domestic violence and violence against women



20 Kosovar perpetrators embarked on a **transformative** Programme for the Treatment of Perpetrators of Violence against Women, the **first** national programme of this kind

65 Armenian media professionals (♀ 43 and ♂ 22) trained in gender-sensitive reporting, increasing their knowledge by **30%**



550 Armenian schoolteachers trained on gender equality principles, increasing their knowledge by **15%**
