About the study session

Aim:

The aim of this study session is to empower young people to advocate for their rights and promote inclusivity and equality in diverse societies. Through education and practical tools, participants will be equipped to challenge structural discrimination and foster a peaceful and democratic Europe.

Objectives:

- Raise awareness and further mainstream on the young people's access to rights and their connection to combat discrimination by inclusion and educative approaches of human rights;
- Introduce the concepts of Human Rights Education, rights-based approach and non-formal educative methodologies to young people who had no previous knowledge on them;
- Exchange knowledge, skills, good practices and opinions among the participants of the study session, ensuring mutual understanding and learning between the young attendees;
- Provide training young people who are relatively new to the youth field and not yet particularly active in their societies, but would like to become more active;
- Make this study session a hub of young people. Our participants will act as multipliers, disseminating the session's results within their respective local and regional communities by a cascading effect of our outputs.
