The 12th edition of the Training Academy on Cultural Routes will take place in Torres Vedras, Arruda dos Vinhos and Vila Franca de Xira, Portugal, from 11 to 13 June 2025, organised by the European Institute of Cultural Routes (EICR) and the European Federation of Napoleonic Cities, carrier network of the Destination Napoleon (Cultural Route of the Council of Europe since 2015) and the European Federation Iter Vitis, carrier network of the Iter Vitis Route (Cultural Route of the Council of Europe since 2009) in cooperation with the Rota Histórica das Linhas de Torres, Association of Portuguese Wine Municipalities (AMPV) and the Torres Vedras Municipality.
