1. TORRES VEDRAS

Torres Vedras is a municipality in the Portuguese district of Lisbon, located approximately 50 kilometers north of the capital, Lisbon. With a population of approximately 83,000 people, this charming town holds significant historical, cultural, and agricultural importance. In this unique city, you can climb to the top of the mountains, visit the castle and historic sites that tell the story of the past, listen to the bells that mark the passage of time, inhale the intense and warm aroma of the countryside, and bathe in the cool waters of the blue sea, which crashes on the long sandy beach.

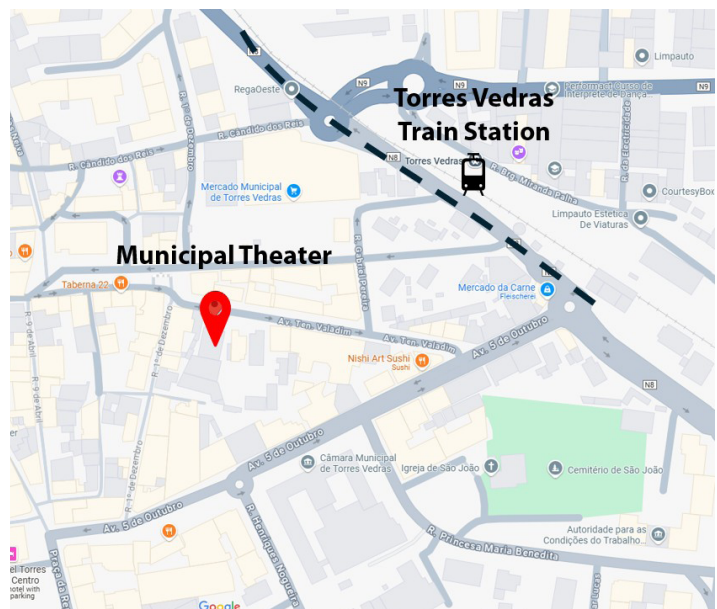
Torres Vedras is embraced by the Atlantic Ocean, stretching over 20 kilometers, where tranquility is enhanced by breathtaking beauty. The streets of the historic center reflect centuries of tradition while shaping the city's unique character. Surrounded by vineyards and the Atlantic, the region produces exceptional wines that pair perfectly with Pastel de Feijão, a delicious flavor of Torres Vedras. The Carnival of Torres Vedras, the most Portuguese of Portugal's carnivals, attracts revelers from all over the world, blending tradition and modernity to offer unique experiences that will surprise you!

2. VENUES

Day 1: Setting the Stage for Collaboration and Sustainability

Venue: Torres Vedras, Municipal Theatre

The first day of the Training Academy will take place at the Municipal Theater / The Teatro-Cine de Torres Vedras (Av. Ten. Valadim 19, 2500-809 Torres Vedras), located in the city center. The theater building was designed in 1922 and inaugurated in 1923 under the name «Ferreira Silva,» in honor of the actor who passed away that year. After its closure, the building was acquired by the Torres Vedras City Council in 1997, which modernized it while preserving the original structure. It officially reopened in 2001.

Day 2: Capacity Building and Practical Solutions

Venue: Arruda dos Vinhos

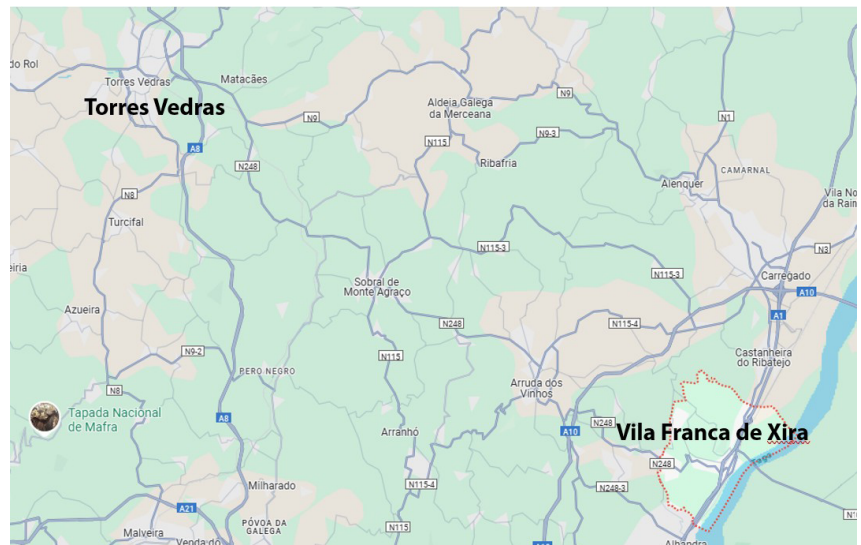
The second day of the Training Academy will be held in Arruda dos Vinhos, a municipality located in the Lisbon District of Portugal. Transportation will be provided by bus from Torres Vedras, with an approximate travel time of 35 minutes.



Day 3: Finalizing Strategies and Defining Next Steps

Venue: Vila Franca de Xira

The third day of the Training Academy will take place in Vila Franca de Xira, a municipality located in the Lisbon District of Portugal. Transportation will be provided by bus from Torres Vedras, with an approximate travel time of 50 minutes.

3. TRANSPORT

The closest airport is in Lisbon, Portugal.

Transportation from Lisbon Airport:

OPTION 1 (duration: 1 hour 15 minutes):

- Once you arrive at the airport
- Take the "Linha Vermelha – Red Line of the Subway", in the direction of "São Sebastião" station
- Get off the subway at the "Oriente" station
- From "Oriente" station go to the bus station to take a Flixbus to Torres Vedras. (<https://global.flixbus.com/bus/lisbon-airport>).

OPTION 2 (duration: 1 hour 30 minutes):

- Once you arrive at the airport
- Take the "Linha Vermelha – Red Line" of the Subway, in the direction of "São Sebastião" station
- Change the subway at the "Alameda" station
- Take the "Linha Verde - Green Line" of the Subway in the direction of "Telheiras" station
- Get off the subway at the "Campo Grande" station
- From "Campo Grande" station go to the bus station to take a "Barraqueiro Oeste" bus, number 700 to Torres Vedras. (<https://www.barraqueiro-oeste.pt/barraqueirooeste/Barraqueiro-Oeste>)

OPTION 3 (duration: 1 hour 30 minutes):

- Once you arrive at the airport
- Take the "Linha Vermelha – Red Line" of the Subway, in the direction of "São Sebastião" station
- Change the subway at the "Saldanha" station
- Take the "Linha Amarela - Yellow line" of the Subway in the direction of "Odivelas" station
- Get off the subway at the "Campo Grande" station
- From "Campo Grande" station go to the bus station to take a "Barraqueiro Oeste" bus, number 700 to Torres Vedras. (<https://www.barraqueiro-oeste.pt/barraqueirooeste/Barraqueiro-Oeste>)

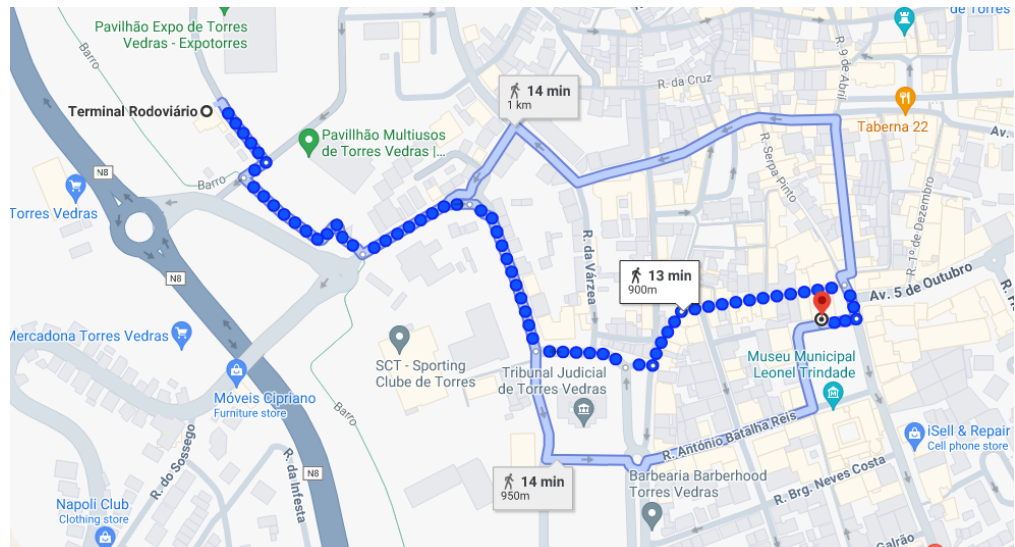

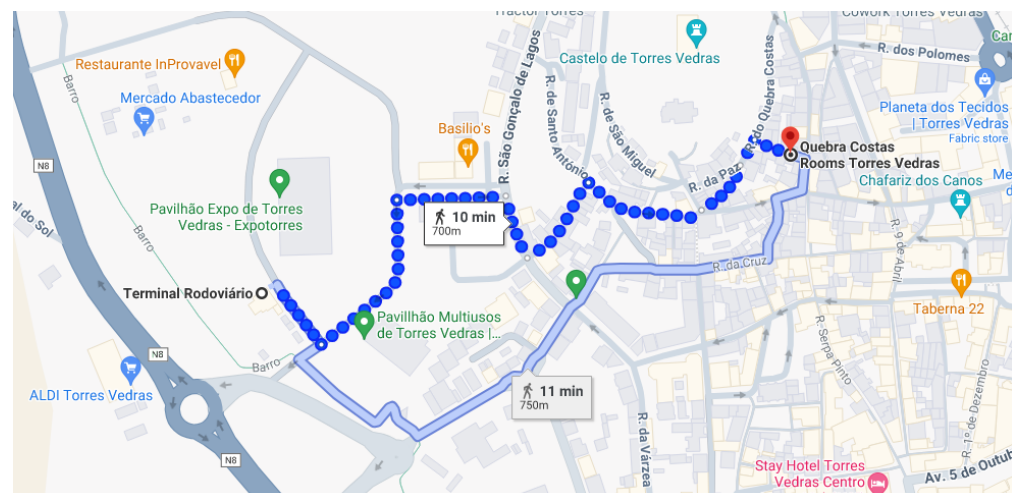


Quebra Costas Rooms Torres Vedras

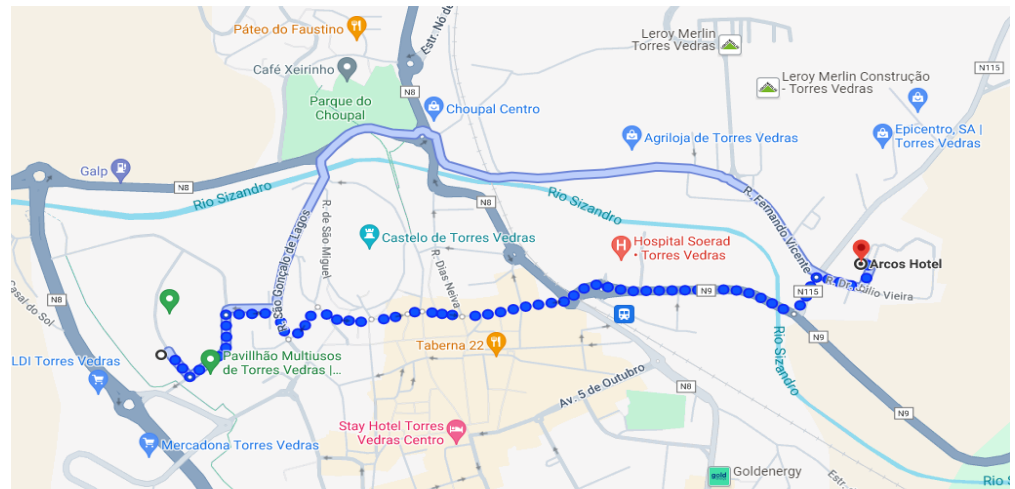

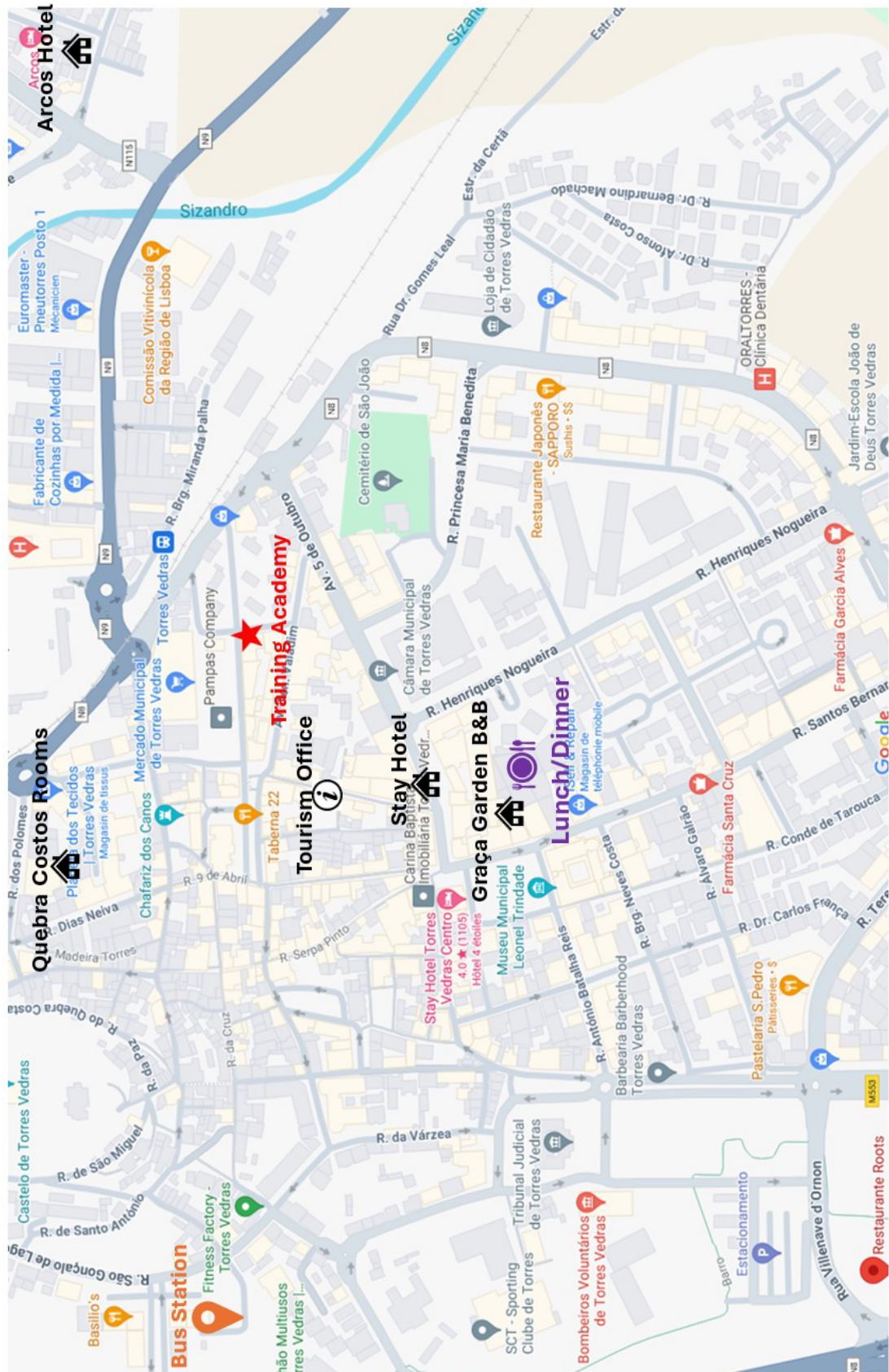

6. DISCOVER TORRES VEDRAS AND ITS SURROUNDINGS

If you wish, you can take advantage of your stay in Torres Vedras to explore the surrounding area. Below are a few suggestions:

Lines of Torres Vedras [National Monument]

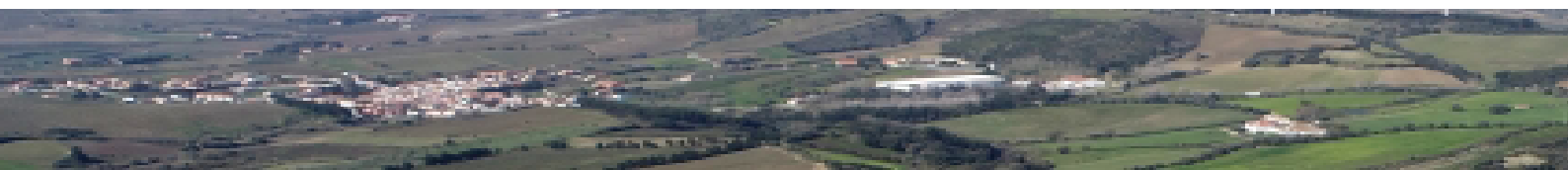


Enjoy a full and memorable day in the fortifications of the municipality that gave the Lines their name. The route begins at the Fort of São Vicente, where the Lines of Torres Vedras Interpretation Centre is located, passing by the Fort of Olheiros and the old medieval castle, adapted to fortify the impregnable defensive system. In the Serra da Archeira, where you can see the towns of Runa and Dois Portos, the scene of two important battles between opposing armies, you'll find the Feiteira Fort. Towards the sea, following the gentle course of the River Sizandro, visit the Grilo and Passo forts, culminating the experience with a view of the Atlantic.

Interpretation Centre of the Lines of Torres Vedras [Chapel Of The Fort Of S. Vicente]



The Interpretation Centre for the Lines of Torres Vedras offers educational experiences that allow visitors to enjoy the heritage more fully through new approaches to the subject, as well as promoting knowledge of the historical importance of the Lines of Torres Vedras.

Forte de São vicente [National monument]



Built in 1809 and considered to be one of the most important and largest military works in the entire defence system, the Fort of São Vicente was equipped with 26 pieces of artillery and a military contingent of 2,000 to 2,200 men, which could accommodate around 4,000 soldiers. It had an optical telegraph inside, which allowed rapid communication with the Grilo Fort and the signal post erected in the Serra do Socorro, the closest command post to Wellington's headquarters.

Torres Vedras Castle [Building of public interest]



All that remains of the medieval castle are the Romanesque remains of the church of Santa Maria and the oval fence, reinforced by King Manuel I, which defended a keep, which was demolished to make way for the new Palácio dos Alcaides, built around 1519 by the mayor João Soares de Alarcão. Today, the Castle's Interpretation Centre, made up of four exhibition areas, welcomes and provides information to visitors, placing them in the context of the property's history and allowing them to explore, interpret and enjoy the monument independently.
