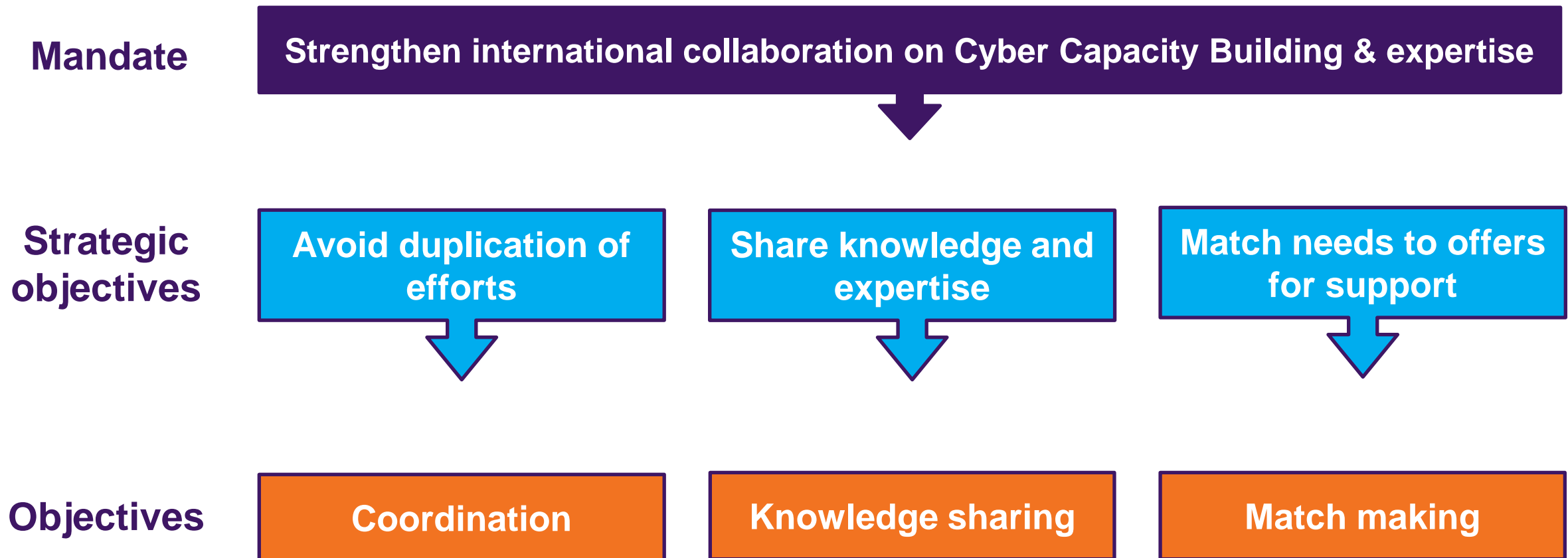
An international response to a global challenge
