5.1 Steering Committee on Media and Information Society (CDMSI)

Abridged report of the 21st meeting

Item to be considered by the GR-H at its meeting on 28 June 2022

Meeting details

The Steering Committee on Media and Information Society (CDMSI) held its 21st meeting in Strasbourg on 1-2 June with Mr Taavo Lumiste as the Chair.

The CDMSI:

Regarding standard setting activities:

- **welcomed** the adoption of deliverables from the previous biennium
 - o Recommendation CM/Rec(2022)4 of the Committee of Ministers to member States on promoting a favourable environment for quality journalism in the digital age
 - o Recommendation CM/Rec(2022)11 of the Committee of Ministers to member States on principles for media and communication governance
 - o Recommendation CM/Rec(2022)12 of the Committee of Ministers to member States on electoral communication and media coverage of election campaigns
 - o Recommendation CM/Rec(2022)13 of the Committee of Ministers to member States on the impacts of digital technologies on freedom of expression
 - o Recommendation CM/Rec(2022)16 of the Committee of Ministers to member States on combating hate speech;
- **took note** of the Committee of Ministers' call, in the decisions taken at the 132nd Session of the Committee of Ministers, held on 20 May 2022 in Turin, for the effective implementation of these instruments by all member States;
- **took note** of the preparation by the Secretariat of two questionnaires aimed at promoting and facilitating the implementation of Council of Europe standards by member States in the CDMSI's fields of competence, which have/will be circulated among CDMSI members:

1) on collecting good practice for the extension of the Implementation Guide to Recommendation CM/Rec(2016)4 of the Committee of Ministers to member States on the protection of journalism and safety of journalists and other media actors (deadline for responses extended until end July 2022) and;

2) on the state of implementation of *Recommendation CM/Rec(2018)2 of the Committee of Ministers to member States on the roles and responsibilities of internet intermediaries, including in light of the developments related to the EU's Digital Services Act package* (deadline for replies: mid-September 2022);

- **took note of** the report of the first meeting of the Committee of Experts on the Integrity of Online Information - MSI-INF (15-16 March 2022) and of the outline for its *draft guidance note on countering the spread of online mis- and disinformation through fact-checking and platform design solutions in a human rights compliant manner*;
- **took note of** the report of the first meeting of the Committee of Experts on Increasing Resilience of Media - MSI-RES (31 March-1 April 2022), of the outline for its draft guidelines on the use of digital tools including artificial intelligence for journalism/by journalists, and of the circulation of a questionnaire on behalf of the MSI-RES regarding the other future deliverable, a *collection of good practice for sustainable media financing* (deadline for replies: mid-September 2022);
- **took note of** the report of the first meeting of the Committee of Experts on Strategic Lawsuits against Public Participation - MSI-SLP (4-5 April 2022) and the outline for its *draft recommendation on strategic lawsuits against public participation*.

As regards the aggression of the Russian Federation against Ukraine:

- **expressed support and solidarity** to Ukraine and discussed examples of support action taken by member States, including steps taken to combat disinformation and propaganda;
- **took note of** the Council of Europe's firm position against the Russian aggression in Ukraine and related decisions by the Council of Europe, in particular the cessation of the Council of Europe membership of the Russian Federation in the Council of Europe;
- **held an exchange** on the consequences for the CDMSI and its Committees of experts and took note of the results of elections held to replace the former members elected on behalf of the Russian Federation, with a view to completing the composition of its expert committees: (Ms Anne-Sophie Sirinelli (France) elected as a MSI-SLP member; Ms Solvita Denisa– Liepniece (Latvia) elected as a MSI-RES member);
- **held an exchange** with Ms Olha Herasymiuk, CDMSI member in respect of Ukraine, who provided an update on the situation in Ukraine, including on the specific measures taken to ensure, despite the armed conflict, due access to information for the Ukrainian population.

In light of the issues raised by some member States in recent years regarding the transfrontier provision of audio-visual media services, the CDMSI:

- **held an exchange** on the state of play of the European Convention on Trans-frontier Television and possible ways forward;
- **committed** to collect and provide further information on issues of concern for member States related to the transfrontier provision of audio-visual media services;
- **decided to set up** a reflection group from among its members to examine the relevant issues and members States' positions and prepare the ground for further reflection at the next plenary meeting.

Regarding digital governance:

- **exchanged views** with Ambassador Rasmus Lumi, Council of Europe Thematic Coordinator on Information Policy TC-INF on the Council of Europe's Digital Agenda 2022-2025 "Protecting human rights, democracy and the rule of law in the digital environment" and **took note of** the latest developments regarding the Council of Europe Convention on Access to Official Documents (Trømsø, CETS No. 205) and the Council of Europe's co-operation with internet companies;
- **Held an exchange** with Ms Marisa Jimenez, European Public Policy Director, META and Ms Anne Hobson, Policy Manager at Reality Labs, META Platforms on the Metaverse project and the implications of the development of virtual realities from the perspective of the Council of Europe's values and principles (rule of law, human rights, and democracy).

Regarding other developments:

- **took note of and discussed developments** of relevance for the CDMSI's work of other Council of Europe bodies and structures:
 - o the Committee on Artificial intelligence (CAI) tasked to prepare a legal instrument on the development, design and application of artificial intelligence systems based on the Council of Europe's standards on human rights, democracy and the rule of law, and conducive to innovation, in accordance with the relevant decisions of the Committee of Ministers;
 - o the Data Protection Unit and its call for ratification of the Amending Protocol for the modernisation of Convention 108;
 - o the division on Co-operation on Freedom of Expression issues and its work on supporting and promoting the implementation of the Council of Europe standards in the field of freedom of expression, with a focus on the action taken to address the situation in Ukraine resulting from the Russian aggression;
 - o the Cybercrime division and the recent opening for signature of the Second Additional Protocol to the Cybercrime Convention (Budapest Convention) on enhanced co-operation and disclosure of electronic evidence;
- **took note** of the information provided by Mr Roberto Fasino, Head of Secretariat, Committee on Culture, Science, Education and Media, Secretariat of the Parliamentary Assembly, on the most recent activities of PACE in the area of freedom of expression and information, and the synergies and complementarity of the work between PACE and the CDMSI, including on the issue of SLAPPs.
- **welcomed** the presentation by Mr Stefano Montanari, Head of Communications Unit / Adviser to the Council of Europe Commissioner for Human Rights on the latest developments of relevance for the CDMSI in the Commissioner's work.
- **held a tour de table** on developments in the member States in the areas of relevance for the CDMSI.

Regarding applications for observer status:

- **approved**, following a presentation and an exchange with the organisations' representatives, the applications for observer status to the Committee of Experts on Strategic Lawsuits against Public Participation - MSI-SLP of:
 - o **Amnesty International**
 - o **The Council of Bars and Law Societies of Europe (CCBE)**

Next meeting:

- **agreed** to hold its next plenary meeting on 7-9 December 2022.

The Committee noted with satisfaction that the results expected under the terms of reference for the previous biennium were achieved despite the constraints related to the Covid-19 pandemic. It stressed the importance of implementation, at the domestic level, of the recently adopted instruments, in line with the Turin decisions of the Committee of Ministers, as well as, as ways to enhance their impact, of their wide promotion, including their translation in national and local languages.
