Achievements/highlights



- **In Türkiye** 3 courses "Introduction to the European Convention on human rights" "Asylum and ECHR" and "Child-friendly Justice" launched in 4 Universities' law faculties (covering nearly 700 students). Courses run in 17 Universities across regions (Ankara, Istanbul, Gaziantep, Sakarya, etc)
- **In Armenia** « Bioethics » course launched for a group of 11 students
- **In Armenia** three HELP courses launched for students for Yerevan University and Centre for European studies : "Asylum and human rights", "CPT standards" for 34 students
- **In Italy** "Bioethics" course launched for 12 law students in 2023
- **In North Macedonia** University St Cyril and Methodius – HELP course on Family law launched for 12 students in 2023
- **University of Jyväskylä (Finland)** "Business and human rights" and "Environment and human rights" courses are run for students, integrated in classes

- **HELP ToT for University professors:**
 - In Ukraine (September 2023)
 - In Western Balkans (October 2023)
 - In Georgia (November 2023)
- Public lectures and raising awareness events in **Central Asia** (Kazakhstan, Uzbekistan, Kyrgyzstan, Tajikistan and Turkmenistan)
