Achievements/highlights

- In Turkiye 3 courses "Introduction to the European Convention on human rights" "Asylum and ECHR" and "Child-friendly Justice" launched in 4 Universities' law faculties (covering nearly 700 students). Courses run in 17 Universities across regions (Ankara, Istanbul, Gaziantep, Sakarya, etc)
- In Armenia « Bioethics » course launched for a group of 11 students
- In Armenia three HELP courses launched for students for Yerevan University and Centre for European studies : "Asylum and human rights", "CPT standards" for 34 students
- In Italy "Bioethics" course launched for 12 law students in 2023
- In North Macadenia University St Cyril and Methodius HELP course on Family law launched for 12 students in 2023
- University of Jyväskylä (Finland) "Business and human rights" and "Environment and human rights" courses are run for students, integrated in classes


