LIST OF DECISIONS

At its first meeting held on 24-25 November 2020, the Follow-up Committee of the Macolin Convention:

- 1. Decided to postpone the election of the Bureau until a next meeting and invited the Secretariat to chair the meeting;
- 2. Adopted the agenda as appears in document T-MC (2020)67.5;
- 3. Adopted its Rules of Procedure as they appear in document T-MC (2020)57.7;
- 4. Decided to grant Observer Status to the following organisations: IOC, INTERPOL and GLMS;
- 5. Decided to invite to participate to its future meetings a representative of the Council of Europe Parliamentary Assembly as well as a representative of each of the following Council of Europe committees:
 - a. the Group of States against corruption (GRECO);
 - b. the Committee of Experts on the Evaluation of Anti-Money Laundering Measures and the Financing of Terrorism (MONEYVAL) and
 - c. the Committee of the Convention for the protection of individuals with regard to automatic processing of personal data (Convention 108);
- 6. Asked the Secretariat to prepare, in co-operation with EPAS, the draft list of Sports Organisations referred to in Article 3.2 of the Convention for its consideration and adoption at the next meeting of the Committee;
- Asked the secretariat to prepare a document including options for the Committee to examine possible approaches to monitoring, and the preparation of a checklist of questions to be addressed to States;
- Agreed on the importance of integrating the Network of National Platforms (Group of Copenhagen) into the Committee's work, welcomed the offer of Mr Mavrotas (Greece) to prepare a draft mandate for the Advisory Group on National Platforms and agreed to invite a representative of the Group of Copenhagen to its next meeting;
- 9. Decided to include in the agenda of its next meeting the following items:
 - List of Sports Organisations;
 - Approach to monitoring, including a draft checklist of questions;
 - Exchange of views with a representative of the Group of Copenhagen;
 - Avenues to address the EU deadlock;
 - New requests for Observers' status.
- 10. agreed to hold its next meeting in May 2021 (exact date to be agreed) and instructed the Secretariat to propose possible dates.
